Occupational First Aid – Q.Q.I. Level 5

Course Description

This course prepares the Trainee to deal with the types of injuries that would be likely to occur in the workplace. Courses are designed to train employees in the correct response to any workplace emergency and comply with the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act (General Applications 2007 (SI No. 299/2007)).

Course Duration

The Occupational First Aid course is delivered over three days (24 hours approx). Assignments are a fundamental part of the course programme and as such the duration element of assignment requirements cannot be precisely defined as this depends on the Trainee.

Course Content

The course content is presented in eight units which include:-

Unit 1	First Aid in the Workplace
Unit 2	Patient Assessment
Unit 3	Respiratory Emergencies
Unit 4	Cardiac First Response
Unit 6	Altered Levels of Consciousness
Unit 7	Musculoskeletal Injuries
Unit 8	Burns and Scalds, Chemicals, Electric shock
